**Subject:- Grant of Yearly Permission to Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri Smarak, Govt. Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Handia, Allahabad-221503, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID AYU0250) with intake capacity of 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2025-26 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder with respect to appeal dated 18.07.2025 -regarding.**


1. This is with reference to your first appeal filed by the **Mr. Manvendra Singh, IAS, DG, Ayush department, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh vide letter no. 136/Shiksha-2561/2025 dated 18.07.2025** to the Commission against the **Yearly Permission with Seat Reduction** issued to **Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri Smarak, Govt. Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Handia, Allahabad-221503, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID AYU0250) with intake capacity of 52 seats (65 seats including EWS) [instead of 60 seats (75 seats including EWS)] in UG (BAMS)** due to non fulfillment of the basic eligibility criteria in terms of NCISM (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals) Regulations, 2024 and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder and other shortcoming as mentioned in **Yearly Permission with Seat Reduction** letter of even no. dated 30.06.2025.
2. The submission made by the **Mr. Manvendra Singh, IAS, DG, Ayush department, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh** was placed before the Chairman, National Commission for Indian System of Medicine and it has been decided by the Chairman, NCISM to consider the appeal on the basis of an **affidavit submitted by Mr. Manvendra Singh, IAS, DG, Ayush department, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh vide ref. No. IN-UP44601546515333X dated 18.07.2025** wherein it is mentioned that the shortcomings/deficiencies shall be fulfilled at the earliest and requesting for Grant of Yearly permission **Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri Smarak, Govt. Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Handia, Allahabad-221503, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID AYU0250) with intake capacity of 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course as per the concerned acts & regulations for the academic session 2025-26.**
3. Further, the Chairman, NCISM directed the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM vide letter no. **51-20/2025-26/Comm. Appeal/College (Ayu.) dated 01.08.2025** to grant Yearly Permission to **Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri Smarak, Govt. Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Handia, Allahabad-221503, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID AYU0250) with intake capacity of 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course** under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26 as per the concerned acts & regulations.

**"DECISION"**

4. Therefore, in view of above, **Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri Smarak, Govt. Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Handia, Allahabad-221503, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID AYU0250)** is hereby granted with :-
  - a) **Yearly Permission in UG (BAMS) course with intake capacity of 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in accordance with Regulation 54(3) of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges 2024.**
5. **The aforementioned decision is issued under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 subject to the condition that following requirements shall be fulfilled:-**
  - (i) It is further informed that minimum **15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of with 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course** shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2025-26 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission**

of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.

6. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations there under.
7. Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
8. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
9. You are hereby instructed to comply with all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the Implementation letters vide. ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS & HMS. Dated 09.05.2024 & 06.09.2024 issued by the Board.
10. **The following requirements must be fulfilled and the compliance report must reach the Board by 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2025 to be considered for the issuance of permission for the academic session 2026-27 :-**
  - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.
  - ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
  - iii) All the requirement of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standard of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2022.
  - iv) Creation of separate Panchakarma department as per the required criteria of MESAR, 2024 which was same communicated to The Principal Secretary, AYUSH Vibhag, Uttar Pradesh Shashan with vide letter vide ref no. 3/2024/MARB/General Matters Dated 23.08.2024.
11. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2025-26.
